

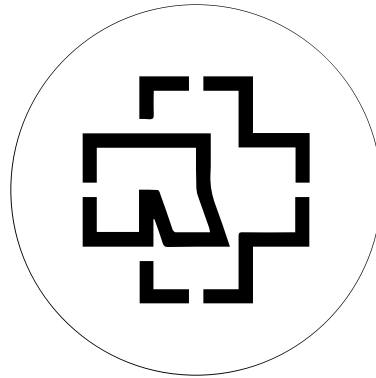
LET'S MAKE BADGES!





Ø 48mm

Ø 37mm



The paper circle needs to be slightly larger (Ø 48mm) than the finished badge size (Ø 37mm) because the edges will fold over the metal shell.

Print your artwork. Standard printer paper (80–120 gsm) works best. Photo paper is often too thick and may cause the machine to jam.



Cut out circles from paper.



Parts of the badge are metal shell, paper circle, plastic film and plastic back.



Slide the white part with metal cups to the left.



Place the metal shell into the left side metal cup, smooth/curved side facing up.



Place your paper circle on top of the metal shell, face up.



Place the clear plastic film on top of the paper



Slide the metal cup under the upper press and pull the handle down firmly. The parts will stay tucked inside the top of the machine.



Place the plastic back into the right side metal cup with the pin side facing down. Ensure the pin is horizontal so your image ends up straight.



Slide the metal cup under the upper press. Pull the handle down again. This time, the machine crimps the front and back together.



Lift the handle, slide the metal cup back, and remove your finished badge.
